

Gilda was born in Detroit, Michigan, the younger of two children of Henrietta (Dworkin), a legal secretary, and Herman Radner, a businessman. She had an older brother, Michael. Her family were Jewish immigrants (from Russia, Poland, and Lithuania) Gilda died of ovarian cancer on the 20th of May, 1989.



Gene Wilder and Gilda's cancer psychotherapist, Joanna Bull, established the first Gilda's Club in 1991 in New York City.

This was Gilda's wish that a place could be established where people of all ages diagnosed with cancer could come together and support one another through the illness. The centers are non-medical and very homey, with an art center, comfortable meeting rooms, an exercise area, a kitchen, a game room and a children's room called Noogieland.

Gilda's Club currently has centers all over the United States and Canada.



Gilda played Roseanne Roseannadanna on the "Weekend Update" segment of "Saturday Night Live" between 1977 and 1980. This character had the ability to gross out costar Jane Curtin with her discussion of other people's gross habits.



- National studies report that social and emotional support are just as important as medical care for those with cancer.






